- 08-09: Two New Fields for Exclusion from Energy Intensity
- 08-10: Exclude Personal Property Trailers
- 08-11: Add a Non-Operating Historical Status

- 09-01: New Usage Code for Monitoring Wells
- 09-02: Add Owned/Ingrant field to standard report #040

08-09: Approved

■ PROPOSED CHANGE:

Create two new fields in the building table to capture information on excluded buildings. FIMS would produce the excluded building list report for the sites and for DOE collectively based on information within FIMS.

■ JUSTIFICATION:

Energy legislation and DOE O 430.2B allow sites to exclude certain buildings from the calculation of energy intensity. Previous reporting of the excluded building list was generated outside of FIMS, resulting in a mismatch between FIMS and the reported data.

With this implementation, FIMS becomes the accepted source of information for excluded buildings rather than the off-line process.

08-10: Approved

■ PROPOSED CHANGE:

Modify FIMS policy guidance and data dictionary to exclude personal property trailers from FIMS. Only Real property trailers would be tracked in FIMS and personal property trailers already entered in FIMS would be removed.

■ JUSTIFICATION:

The inclusion of personal property trailers causes confusion in data analysis and reporting and contributes no useful information. FIMS is a real property database. Personal property trailers should be tracked in the personal property database. This change was overwhelmingly supported at the 2008 FIMS/real estate workshop.

08-11: Not Approved

■ PROPOSED CHANGE:

Add a status of “Non-Operating Historical” to the picklist

■ JUSTIFICATION:

The current status picklist does not reflect the predominant physical/operation status of a non-operating asset that is considered to be of historical significance. These structure cannot be demolished.

FAC NOT APPROVED, AUGUST 20, 2008 –

The FAC recommended a revision to the definition for the status code :Shutdown Pending D&D”

08-12: Approved

■ PROPOSED CHANGE:

Remove the following data element changes in FIMS:

- UFAS Compliance, exemption, and justification
- Escalation year, services, other, and taxes from the "Ingrant 2" window
- Transfer to PSO field from the property detail window
- Landlord Funding Program from the "Site Info window".

■ JUSTIFICATION:

Based on a lengthy discussion at the 2008 workshop, it was determined that these fields are not being utilized by the user community and therefore should be removed from FIMS.

09-01: Approved

■ PROPOSED CHANGE:

Add OSF Usage Code for monitoring wells: Usage Code 5007 Monitoring Well(s), unit of measure = EACH (FRPC Usage Code 50 - Industrial)

Definition:

A well or group of wells designed and installed to obtain representative ground water quality samples. Provides controlled access to ground water samples for analysis, such as to determine the amount, type, and spread of contaminants.

■ JUSTIFICATION:

Creating this usage code was agreed upon at the 2008 FIMS/Real Estate Workshop. This will also facilitate tracking and reporting of monitoring wells throughout DOE

03/25/09 DEFINITION WAS UPDATED TO ADD "OR A GROUP OF WELLS"

09-02: Approved

PROPOSED CHANGE:

Can prop_owned_ingrant be added to the Excel output for report 040 Owned Complete Information Report? The field is available for the Building, Land and Trailer report

JUSTIFICATION:

This is an FRPC-validated data element field. It should be reported in the OSF reports, as in all other reports.


